ABOUT THE GALA: The 11th annual *A Night of Hope Gala* is a black-tie fundraising dinner to benefit the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation Capitol Chapter. More than 500 Washingtonians will gather at the National Building Museum for cocktails, a seated dinner, silent and live auctions and live entertainment. A highlight of the event is the presentation of the Living & Giving Award to a person or company that has made a significant contribution to our mission to find a cure for type 1 diabetes. This year we honor Wells Fargo for their outstanding dedication to JDRF. Our 2010 event raised over \$1 million for diabetes research and we hope to surpass that amount this year.

ABOUT JDRF: The mission of JDRF is to find a cure for diabetes and its complications through the support of research. Type 1 diabetes is an autoimmune disease that strikes children and adults suddenly, and can be fatal. Until a cure is found, people with type 1 diabetes have to test their blood sugar and give themselves insulin injections multiple times or use a pump - each day, every day of their lives. Since its founding in 1970 by parents of children with type 1 diabetes, JDRF has awarded more than \$1.4 billion to diabetes research, and more than 85% of JDRF's expenditures directly support research and research-related education.
